The focus of this multi-stakeholder event is sharing the information and data collected from our previous workshops and engagements and using this to work together to explore solutions to the long-standing problems with practice placement education. **The output will be an agreed action plan to increase HSCP practice placements and ultimately increase supply of HSCP available to work in the health and social care services.**

In order to achieve this it is essential that we have representation from all key stakeholder groups, including professions, roles, a 50:50 ratio of HSCP working in clinical practice: higher education institutions, and balanced geographical coverage.
