Applicants Role & Managers Role

The Role of the Line Manager

As a line manager it is your responsibility to:

- Ensure a meeting is held between you and the applicant in order to discuss the application
- Prepare for this meeting by working through the form, considering what you would like to contribute and anticipating reactions
- Offer advice and guidance to the applicant, considering both their best interests and the interests of the department/team
- Come to an appropriate and realistic decision as to whether or not the application will be supported.
- If it is not to be supported, the reasons should be clear and specific. Alternative development actions should be agreed with the individual.

The Role of the Applicant

As an applicant it is your responsibility to:

- Consider if this course of study is in line with your career development and with the needs of the department/organisation
- Arrange a meeting with your manager to discuss the application for support. In advance of this meeting you should fill out the form in draft so that you have considered your responses to some of the questions
- Accept and (if necessary) clarify the feedback and advice that your line manager may give you in relation to the application
- Should you be successfully chosen you must commit in writing to completing the course in line with the agreed terms and conditions herein. Therefore you should fully understand in advance of making the application the level of commitment required and be prepared to maximise the benefit of this course both for yourself and the department/organisation.
